Real World English plus Introduction to Thai Language Proposal

Course Description

This course is designed to help students understand simple information in texts and audio/video which focus on familiar topics. At this level, students' English language ability will be improved to the level that they can exchange their ideas in the relevant topics which are not too difficult.

In addition, students will gain some understanding and familiarity about the "five" tones of Thai language and whilst also building basic vocabulary for real life situations.

Learning Outcomes

- 1. Students will be able to use expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance.
- 2. Students will be able to communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.
- 3. Students will be able to describe in simple terms aspects of their background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.
- 4. Students will be able to understand "five" tones of Thai language
- 5. Students will be able to give a basic introduction and converse in various different situations.
