


The Hirosaki University International House provides accommodation and facilities for overseas students, Japanese students and researchers.

Hirosaki University has other dormitories at other locations. If you need more details, check from the QR code.



Shared facilities

Building A



Auto-lock entrance

All entrances are equipped with 24-hour security.



Mail box

Mailboxes are located near the building A and B entrances. Please check your Mailbox everyday!







Shared hallway

This is a shared hallway. Please keep it clean and quiet.





Lounge

This Lounge can be used for chatting with friends, but may not be used for parties or gatherings without prior permission.



Laundry room

There is a common laundry room on the 1st floor of the building A for the use of single-room occupants.

Washing: 100 yen/per time Dry: 100 yen/per time



Garbage area

Check the refuse collection calendar. Take out garbage to the dump by 8am of the appropriate collecting date.

Bicycle parking

If you would like to use your bicycle, make sure to park it in the bicycle parking area.



Please keep it clean.




Bedroom

Study space

Each room has a desk, chair and desk light. These should be used with care and should not be taken out of your room.

Each room has air conditioning near the bed. It can be used for both cooling and heating.



Interphone

Each room has an interphone with a camera. You can check and see who is at your door before you open it.



Shoe storage

Each room has storage space for shoes at the entrance.






Type B rooms have an air conditioning in the bed room. It can be used for both cooling and heating.



There is a vacuum cleaner in each room.


About the International House

The International House doesn't have any smoking area!







•FLOOR SPACE Type A: 14m² Building A, 31 rooms



Type B: 33m Building B, 10 rooms



Type C: 50m Building B, 7 rooms





Type A: 20,000 yen / per month Type B: 26,000 yen / per month

Type C: 32,000 yen / per month (for one occupant) Type C: 16,000 yen / per month (for two occupants) •CLEANING FEES (to be paid when you leave)

Type A: 20,000 yen \sim 22,000 yen Type B: 33,000 yen \sim 35,000 yen Type C: 43,000 yen \sim 47,000 yen

*This fee depends on how long you lived in the room.

XIf the room is very dirty, damaged or items are missing when you leave the International House, you

have to pay an additional restoration fee.


